## MAXIMUM TRAVEL EXPENDITURE

WHEREAS, Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:11-12, in each pre-budget year, the Salem Board of Education is required to establish a maximum travel expenditure amount for the budget year which may not be exceeded; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Education has determined that the maximum travel expenditure amount includes all travel that is supported by State and local funds; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Education had previously established a maximum amount for the pre-budget year 2019-2020 as \$100,000 and

WHEREAS, The Board of Education has expended \$14,485 of the maximum amount for the pre-budget year to date; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Education has not elected to exclude travel expenditures supported by federal funds from the maximum travel expenditure amount; and

WHEREAS, The board has determined that the total amount of travel expenditures supported by federal funds is \$1,025 for the prebudget year to date; and

WHEREAS, The board has determined that the total amount of travel expenditures supported by federal funds for the school year 2020-2021 is \$30,000, be it

**RESOLVED,** That the Salem City Board of Education hereby establishes the maximum travel expenditure amount for the <u>2020-2021</u> school year as \$100,000.
