

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between Rowan University, Henry M. Rowan College of Engineering & Salem City School District August 1, 2017

This articulation agreement specifies the requirements and conditions for students at **Salem High School** to obtain articulated academic credit at Rowan University for the *Project Lead the Way* Pathway to Engineering courses completed at the high school.

The requirements are as follows:

- 1. The high school must offer the end-of-course exams for all of the *Project Lead the Way* Pathway to Engineering courses for which they are available as stipulated in their agreement with *Project Lead the Way*.
- 2. The student must successfully complete four *Project Lead the Way* engineering courses.
- 3. Student achieves an average stanine score of 5.5 and no score lower than 4.0 on the *Project Lead the Way* end-of-course exam for each course.
- 4. Student must be accepted into one of the Rowan University engineering programs.
- 5. Rowan University will contact the high school to verify course completion and successful test completion.

Students that meet the above requirements will be awarded credit for Freshman Engineering Clinic 1 (ENGR01101, 2 credits) and Freshman Engineering Clinic 2 (ENGR01102, 2 credits). Students desiring to accept these credits should notify the PLTW Affiliate Director upon admission into the College of Engineering.

Annual review of the articulation agreement will be performed in June. Any changes to the agreement will apply to incoming students of Salem High School (i.e., rising Salem High School freshman).
