

Salem High School Virtual Instructional Plan

Phase 1

Virtual Fridays

All students will begin virtual instruction on Fridays on October 23rd.

- **Students will attend school in-person Monday through Thursday and will be virtual on Friday**
- **Virtual Fridays will occur until Thanksgiving Break**
- **November 20th will be the last Virtual Friday of Phase 1**

Phase 2

All Virtual

All students will receive 100 % Virtual Instruction beginning on November 30th.

- **Students will utilize their Chromebooks/Surfaces for Virtual Instruction**
- **All Virtual Instruction will occur from November 30th to February 26th**
- **Each student's virtual schedule will be similar to the student's in-person schedule (refer to slides 4, 5, & 6)**
- **Students will be required to be present in each virtual class during its scheduled time.**

What Does a Virtual School Day Look Like?

- **Students are required to log on and participate in their classes during the scheduled class time**
- **Students will still have a double period of Science on their lab day**
- **Students are expected to be present during each scheduled class period**
- **Student attendance will be factored into the class participation grade**

What Will Instruction Look Like?

- Teachers will utilize Google Classroom for all assignments and student communication
- Live instruction will occur via Google Meet
- Students will not be permitted to report to a job during school hours
- If a student does not participate in the lesson, he/she will be marked absent and responsible for completing any assignments for the class period
- Teachers will be utilizing Google Classroom to post and collect all assignments

The goal of the SHS Virtual Learning Plan is to emulate the school day as closely as possible and to provide daily student-teacher interaction as guided by research.

Phase 3

Return to In-Person Instruction

- Students will resume in-person instruction full time (5 days per week) beginning March 1st* until the end of the school year
- Any student who returns to virtual instruction from remote instruction must return to school on March 1st*
- The deadline for students who are currently on remote instruction to opt back in for Virtual Instruction is November 11th

*** All dates are subject to change due to the current circumstances**

Additional Supports

- **Daily office hours for students who need assistance are available from 2:45 to 3:45 PM each day Monday through Thursday for core content areas and college level courses (AP & IB)**
- **School Counseling services will continue during virtual learning**
- **Intervention and Referral Services (I&RS) will continue during virtual learning**

Social and Emotional Learning and Support

- **School counselors will continue with individual student and parent meetings. Meetings will take place virtually or in-person by appointment.**
- **Students, parents, and teachers will email counselors if a student is in need of academic or emotional support.**
