Salem High School is an International Baccalaureate School which serves 320 students in grades 9-12 from Salem City, Quinton, Lower Alloway's Creek, Elsinboro and Mannington Township. Salem High School has a faculty comprised of 55 members. Salem High School has every classroom equipped with Internet accessible computers while boasting 5 state of the art computer labs, 4 new state of the art Science labs, a distance learning video conferencing classroom and the largest Auditorium/Performance Center in Salem County. All classrooms are equipped with Star Boards.

Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 130 credits which must include: 4 years of Language Arts, 3 years of Mathematics, 3 years of Science, 1 year of World History, 2 years of US History, 4 years of Health and Physical Education, 1 year of Fine and/or Performing Art & 1 year of a Practical Art, 1 year of World Language and passing scores on one of the following standardized tests: SAT, ACT, PARCC, ASVAB, PSAT and/or Accuplacer.
