Acceptable Use of Internet

- The purpose of technology use in schools is to facilitate the need to prepare student so to become computer literate in an increasingly technological world, to foster educational and personal growth in technology, information gathering, and communication skills.
- The primary use of the Internet shall be to utilize materials that are of “educational value” – that have an impact on the educational program.

TAKE NOTE:

The use of the system for defamatory, inaccurate, abusive, obscene, profane, sexually oriented, threatening, and racially offensive, and illegal material or other prohibited activities shall not be permitted.

Any attempt to circumvent system security, guess passwords, or in any way gain unauthorized access to local or Internet resources is forbidden.

The Salem City Board of Education expressly forbids cyber-bullying – using the communication capabilities of computers, the Internet, and/or other digital communication devices to bully others.

- Students who violate the Internet guidelines of the school district may be denied future Internet privileges for a defined period of time or other disciplinary measures set forth in the Student Code of Conduct or in any other rules of the District may be applicable.
