The annual school spirit revelry that is part of homecoming for **Salem High School** gets started on Saturday, October 14, with a parade in downtown Salem that starts opposite the 49 Deli Market, 49 West Broadway, Salem. The parade will start at 11 a.m. and travels east on Broadway, turning right on Walnut Street and ending at the Walnut Street Field across from John Fenwick Academy, rear of The John B. Campbell Center.
